1. Section 1. Operations: Significant Activities

The 1st Battalion, 30th Artillery, continues in general support of the 1st Cavalry Division (Airmobile) during the period 1 October 1969 through 31 October 1969. This period saw the continuation of operation TOAN THANG III CTZ and continued participation in the 1st Cavalry Division (Airmobile) operation KENTUCKY COUGAR.

a. **Organization:** At the beginning of the reporting period, Battery A, GSR to the 2nd Battalion, 19th Artillery, was located at FSB JAMIE (XT 481714). Battery B (-) GSR to the 2nd Battalion, 19th Artillery, was located at FSB GRANT (XT 387623). Battery B Platoon, GSR to the 1st Battalion, 21st Artillery, was located at FSB MARRY (YU 138072). Battery C (-) GSR to the 1st Battalion, 77th Artillery, was located at FSB JERRY (XU 956914). Battery C Platoon was located at FSB WESCOTT (XT 960225). On 7 October 1969, Battery C Platoon was airlifted from FSB WESCOTT to FSB VIVIAN (XU 900014). On 11 October 1969, Battery C (-) moved from FSB JERRY to FSB ELLEN (YU 038063). On 13 October 1969, Battery B (-), was airlifted from FSB GRANT to the 155 position at CAMP GORVAD. On 13 October 1969 Battery A Platoon moved from FSB JAMIE to FSB GRANT (XT 387623). On 14 October 1969, Battery B (-), was airlifted from CAMP GORVAD to FSB JUDIE (YU 255145).

b. **Operation: Chronological Sequence of Events**

(1) On 2 October 1969, at 0325 hours, CAMP GORVAD received 6 rounds of 107 rockets.
